Merry Christmas - The Polish Way

- ♦ The four weeks of Advent in Poland are a time of fasting, prayer and spiritual preparation. Earlymorning Masses are held by candlelight, symbolizing the vigilance and waiting for the coming of Christ. Time is also spent making decorations and open-air markets are held selling a variety of Christmas wares.
- ♦ December 6. świety Mikołaj (Shvee ehn tih mee koh why), St. Nicholas Day for children. St. Nicholas, in bishops attire, appears at schools or homes with a small treat, asking each child if they have been naughty or nice and if they know their prayers.
- ♦ Christmas Eve, Wigila (vih gee lee ah) in the Polish tradition is the most important religious and family occasion of the year. It is celebrated with the sharing of the oplatek (oh pwah tehk), before the Wigilia dinner. This is a wafer symbolizing holy communion, and is broken between the dinner guests while exchanging wishes of good health & good fortune. Hay is placed on top of or under the tablecloth, symbolizing the hay in the manger. The first star appearing in the sky marks the beginning of the meal, the sharing of the wafer and a prayer of thanksgiving. It is a meatless meal of seven, nine or twelve courses consisting of herring, beet or potato soup, fish, vegetable dishes (cabbage & mushrooms, noodles & poppyseed, pierogi), fruit compote, poppy seed cake and other similar favorite family dishes. After the meal, all gather to sing carols - **Koledy** (koh <u>lehn</u> dih) - exchanging gifts, visiting and if possible attending Midnight Mass.
- ♦ Christmas Day, Bożego Narodzenia begins with attending Mass, followed by feasting and socializing, a family day. Kolednicy (koh lehnd nee tsih), carolers begin making their rounds
- ♦ December 26, świętego Szczepana (shvee ehn teh goh shcheh pah nah), St. Stephen's Day is a national holiday and the celebrating, visiting and singing continues. In olden times, people threw oats at each other to commemorate the stoning of St. Stephen, the first Christian martyr.
- December 31, is called Sylwestra (sihl veh strah), the feast day of St. Sylvester. Like in America, this evening is celebrated with food, dances and parties to welcome the new year.
